





XC Update: County colours for MADJA

Three Madja runners made the Wiltshire Schools team sheet to compete at the English Schools Cross Country Championships at Temple Newsome, Leeds on March 19th. They are Catriona Edington, Maddie George and new member Oscar Palmer — all from Dauntsey's School. Congratulations on this fabulous effort.

Early February snow blizzards caused the cancellation of the South West Schools Cross Country champs, but we were delighted to see all three senior runners were due to be joined by two younger club members, also selected for the Wiltshire Schools team — Jacob Pritchard & new member Matthew Nocton.

Both Matthew and Jacob and Catriona had also been in action in the SW

Inter-counties XC at Aldon Hill, Yeovil at the beginning of January. Jacob came a creditable 11th in the U13 boys in the race which was just over 3km, with a time of 12.59secs. Matthew was just 22 seconds behind and came in 22nd. Catriona came 11th in the U20 women's race. All qualified for the Wiltshire County Team for the National Inter-county XC Championships, set for March 9 at Prestwold Hall, Loughborough, along with Sophie Bonnetti who is the U17G reserve.

Meanwhile, well done to **Imogen Newby** for competing in the Oxford Mail League XC league with our friends Team Kennet over the winter months — including running across frozen snowy course February 3rd!
